TOURNAMENT OR GAMES HOSTING AGREEMENT

In consideration of permission being granted to Sachem, Smithtown, and West Islip Soccer Clubs to hold a tournament or games at Sachem, Smithtown and West Islip Holtsville, Smithtown, West Islip NY (State)

On the dates of August 20 & 21, 20 22, we agree to the following conditions:

ABIDE BY RULES: We shall abide by all statements made in our approved US Youth Soccer Application to Host A Tournament or Games, in our tournament invitation, in our tournament rules, in the US Youth Soccer Travel and Tournament Policy and in this US Youth Soccer Tournament or Games Hosting Agreement.

INVITATIONS: The tournament or games approval form shall accompany all tournament or games invitations distributed.

HOUSING: We agree that we will not require a team to use only accommodations approved or provided by the hosting organization or other organization, unless disclosure is made on the tournament application form of the required hotel/motel names and the guaranteed rates.

PROCURING LIABILITY INSURANCE: We have procured liability insurance coverage for the tournament or games with limits of not less than \$1,000,000/\$2,000,000 which names the State Association or Affiliate with which the Hosting Organization is a member.

REQUIRING MEDICAL AUTHORIZATIONS: We shall require all teams participating in the tournament or games to provide medical releases for each player in an appropriate form.

ADVANCE PUBLICATION OF RULES: We agree that our tournament or games rules shall be included with the invitation sent to each team and shall, again, be published to all teams accepted prior to the start of the tournament/games.

CREDENTIALS CHECKS: We agree that we shall conduct credentials checks to ensure that all players are registered with US Youth Soccer or US Soccer or a member thereof or their national association, properly rostered with their team, and participating in accordance with representations set forth on the US Youth Soccer Application to Host a Tournament or Games.

USE OF US SOCCER REGISTERED REFEREES: We agree that we shall use for all games only US Soccer registered referees who are in good standing (unless US Soccer has granted a waiver to allow the use of authorized referees from another country), and shall use a one- or 3-referee system.

AVAILABILITY OF POLICE AND RESCUE SERVICE: We have notified the local police, ambulance, and emergency rescue services of the date of the tournament or games and the times and fields which will be used for games, and have been advised by them that they will be available to render assistance if needed.



TOURNAMENT OR GAME RULES – BEHAVIOR: We agree that our tournament or game rules contain provisions ensuring that the behavior of teams, players, coaches, and spectators is appropriately controlled, including specific provisions that—

- Spell out the disciplinary measures to be imposed for the issuance of red and yellow cards or other improper conduct;
- indicate what procedures will be followed regarding protests and appeals;
- indicate that all disciplinary measures imposed by hosting organizations shall be limited to placing restrictions upon an individual's group participation in the tournament/games;
- record the issuance of all red and yellow cards and other matters involving the conduct of a team, its players, coaches, and supporters and also report them immediately to the home State Association and the home club/league of the team; and
- state that the home State Association or member thereof and the home club or league shall, except in the case of referee assault or abuse, have the responsibility for imposing, should circumstances warrant, additional penalties within their respective jurisdictions with regard to any matters arising from the tournament or games.

TOURNAMENT CANCELLATION: We agree that our tournament or game rules shall state what refunds, if any, shall be made to participating teams if all or a portion of the tournament or games is cancelled by the hosting organization for any reason.

POST TOURNAMENT OR GAMES REPORT: We agree that we shall file any required Post Tournament or Games Report with the State Association or Affiliate granting us permission to host this tournament or games within 30 days after the conclusion of the tournament or games. We understand that failure to file the report may preclude the tournament/games host from receiving approval for any tournament/games for the following seasonal years until the report is filed. The Post Tournament or Games Report shall include the following information:

- the number of teams participating in each age group (boys and girls);
- if a champion is determined, the name of the champion for each group;
- the number of teams from each State Association, Affiliate, other Organization Member, or foreign country;
- if "Sportsmanship Awards" are given, the criteria for the award and to whom awards were given;
- the number of fields used for the tournament/games;
- the name of the sponsor, if any; and
- the names and teams of all players issued red and yellow cards, and details of any other matters involving the improper or unsporting conduct of a team, its players, coaches or supporters. **NOTE: Any incident of referee assault or referee abuse by a player, coach, manager, club official, or game official must be reported to the alleged offender's home State Association, or member thereof immediately, but in no event later than 48 hours after an incident of referee assault or abuse..**

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2022 Long Island Soccer Classic RULES OF PLAY

The LONG ISLAND SOCCER CLASSIC Tournament Committee reserves the right to rule on any situation not specifically listed below. **The Tournament Committee's interpretation of these rules shall be final.**

All tournament games will be played in accordance with the Laws of the Game as issued by FIFA unless modified herein.

The following statement of the Rules and Regulations supplement the Laws of the Game.

All Coaches and Teams must upload their required documents at least 7 days prior to the start of the tournament.

RULE 1: ELIGIBILITY

1. All players must be born in their age group or later.
 - U-19 Born on or after January 1, 2004
 - U-17 Born on or after January 1, 2006
 - U-16 Born on or after January 1, 2007
 - U-15 Born on or after January 1, 2008
 - U-14 Born on or after January 1, 2009
 - U-13 Born on or after January 1, 2010
 - U-12 Born on or after January 1, 2011
 - U-11 Born on or after January 1, 2012
 - U-10 Born on or after January 1, 2013
 - U-9 Born on or after January 1, 2014
 - U-8 Born on or after January 1, 2015
2. No player is allowed to be registered with more than one team in the same bracket or transfer to another team in the same bracket during the tournament.
3. A team not within the jurisdiction of the Eastern New York State Youth Soccer Association or US Club must present a Permission to Travel Form from their State or National Association at team registration.
4. USYSA Player Passes and Medical Release forms will be verified against the Official State Roster and are to be carried by the team supervisor throughout the tournament competition. A tournament official or referee may check passes at any time.
5. Failure to have a player pass or birth certificate will make a player ineligible to participate in any tournament games.
6. Any team that violates the Eligibility Rules shall forfeit the game in which the ineligible player has participated. The team will also be subject to disqualification from the tournament and the forfeiture of all fees.

- The game ball will be provided by the home team on the schedule.
- Ball size: size 4 for U-8 through U-12, and size 5 for U-13 through U-19.

RULE 5: DURATION OF GAME

1. All games in the U-8 age group will consist of 2 halves of 20 minute each.
2. All games in the U-9 through U-12 age groups will consist of 2 halves of 25 minute each.
3. All games in the U-13 thru U-19 age groups will consist of 2 halves of 30 minute each.
4. The intervals between halves will be 5 minutes.
5. Games will be played with a running clock.
6. **Due to scheduling constraints, there will be no warm-up time allowed on the field prior to the start of a game.**
7. Field Marshals will make sure that all games proceed on schedule.
8. The tournament committee reserves the right to shorten halves in order to finish games before sunset.

RULE 6: POSITION OF PLAYERS & SPECTATORS

1. Each team's coaches and players will take position on the opposite side of the spectators during the time that the game is in progress. The team listed first on the schedule is the designated HOME team.
2. No coach, player, or spectator will be permitted beyond the 18-yard line.
3. No coach, player, or spectator will be permitted behind the goal line.

RULE 7: LINES-PERSON

1. Each U-8 through U-12 team must provide a lines-person at each game, except during a pandemic.
2. U-13 and above will use a three referee system.

RULE 8: SUBSTITUTIONS

1. Substitutions can be made without limit at the following times with the permission of the referee at the centerline:
 0. Either team scores a goal
 1. Throw-in for either team
 2. Either team's goal kick
 3. Halftime
 4. Other stoppages, such as free kicks, corner kicks.
2. Limited substitutions may be made for an injury with the referee's permission. In the case of play stoppage for an injury, teams may substitute on a one-for-one basis for the injured player only. If the injured player is replaced, the opposition may also substitute one player.

1. There will be no protests. A protest of a game based upon the utilization of a substitute referee will not be considered.

RULE 14: FORFEITS

1. A team shall forfeit the game if it refused to play after being instructed to do so by the Referee or any Tournament Official. If the team to which the game is being forfeited is ahead at the time of forfeit, the score will stand as is; otherwise, the game will be recorded as 3-0 in favor of the offended team.
2. In all divisions playing 11v11, a game may not start with fewer than 7 properly uniformed players on each team. Furthermore, after a game is started, it may not continue with fewer than 7 players per team.
3. In all divisions that play 8v8 or 9v9, a game may not start with fewer than 6 properly uniformed players on each team. Furthermore, after a game has started, it may not continue with fewer than 6 players on a team.
4. Should a team not have the minimum number of players required within 5 minutes of the scheduled start of a game, it shall forfeit the game by a score of 3-0.
5. Any team forfeiting a game will not be awarded a trophy, and the next placing team will be moved up in the standings.

RULE 15: WEATHER & REFUNDS

1. The Tournament Committee reserves the right to make the following changes in the event of inclement weather.
 0. Relocate and/or reschedule a match
 1. Reduce scheduled duration of a match
 2. Postpone a match
2. In the event of lightning, the tournament director will sound an **Air Horn**. At that time, all games will cease.
3. Should a match in progress be after halftime, the game will be considered official, and the score at the time of termination shall stand.
 0. All games still in the first half will cease with the game clock to continue running, and all players and spectators are to leave the playing fields and go to their cars after fifteen (15) minutes, if no lightning is seen, the tournament director will sound the air horn again, and players, coaches, and refs will return to the field to continue the scheduled match. Match will end at the scheduled time.
 1. In the event that lightning is seen within the first 15-minute delay, the Tournament Director will wait another fifteen (15) minutes. If after the second delay, no lightning is seen, the Tournament Director will sound the air horn again, and players, coaches, and refs will return to the field to continue the scheduled match. Match will end at the scheduled time. If lightning is seen during the second delay, the game will be canceled and the score recorded as 1-1 TIE.
4. If a game is called due to the weather, the score will be recorded as a 1 - 1 TIE.

4. Most shutouts
5. Penalty kicks
2. All divisions will have a minimum of 4 games scheduled.
3. In the final match to determine first and second place only, if a game is tied after regulation, there will be no overtime. The game will go to sudden death penalty kicks to decide the winner.

RULE 20: GAMES PER DIVISIONS THAT ARE NOT A FIVE TEAMS DIVISION

1. 4 TEAM DIVISION.

After the first three games are played by each team, the team with the most points shall play the team in second place and the team in third place shall play the team with the least number of points. (The tie-breaking procedure may come into play to place the teams accordingly). The fourth game shall be considered either the championship game (first vs second place) or the consolation game (third vs fourth place). The winner of the championship game shall be the division winner and the loser of the championship game shall be considered the second-place finisher in the division. The winner of the consolation game shall be considered the third-place finisher in the division and the loser of the consolation game shall be considered the fourth-place finisher in the division.

2. 5 TEAM DIVISION.

Round Robin most points will be declared Division Champions second most points will be declared Division Finalist.

3. 6 TEAM DIVISION.

Each team will play three games against all teams in the opposing bracket. After each team has played three games, the team with the most points from bracket A will play the team with the most points from bracket B to determine the winner of the division. The team with the second-most points from bracket A will play the team with the second-most points from bracket B to determine the third place. The team with the least point in bracket A will play the team with the least points from bracket B to determine 5th place.

RULE 21: AWARDS

1. After all games, the first place team shall be the Champion and the second-place team shall be the Finalist.
2. All champions and finalists will receive awards

RULE 22: DEFINITION OF EXITING TEAM

1. Any team playing in the tournament is required to use their registered name provided they have not registered more than 4 guest players (for U13 and older) or 3 guest players (for U12 and under) for the tournament.
